1. Mining Engineers (Period of one year)

Educational Qualifications and Experience:

Educational: (1. or 2.below)

1. A Bachelor of Science specialized in Mining and Minerals Engineering Degree, which is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC).
2. A Bachelor of Science specialized in Earth Resources Engineering Degree, which is recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC).

And

Service Experience

A minimum one (01) year post qualifying experience in the field of mining relevant to the post, after obtaining the first degree.

Age Limit:

Should be not below 22 years and not above 45 years.

2. Field Assistants (Period of one year)

Educational Qualifications and Experience:

Educational

1. Having passed the GCE (O/L) Examination with six (06) subjects including English Language and four (04) credit passes for Sinhala / Tamil, Mathematics, and two (02) other subjects in one sitting.

And

2. Having passed the GCE (A/L) Examination with three (03) subjects (other than the General Paper)

And

3. Having obtained the Certificate in Computing of a recognized Institute.

As this job involves field visits candidates should have a valid Motor Cycle license. Preference will be given to candidates having own motor cycle.
